#### SHOW AND TECH/PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE - You MUST be available during tech week:

**Rehearsals** will begin with a company meeting on April 23, 2024, from 7pm-10pm (children will be released by 8:30pm). The rehearsal schedule will be given out at the company meeting on April 23, 2024. Weeknight rehearsals will be from 7:00pm to 10:00pm (a few may begin at 6pm). Weekends may be extended blocks of time with a break and then back for additional rehearsal. To keep with 3-4 on average rehearsals a week we will need some extended rehearsals on some weekends.

**Tech and show dates:** We load in on Sunday, July 7 - everyone is expected to help with load in. There will be a rehearsal that evening. Tech week is Monday – Thursday, July 8-11. Performance dates are Friday, July 12 at 7pm, July 13 at 2pm. No show on Sunday the 14th. July 20 is a two-show day at 2pm and 7pm. Closing is July 21at 2pm show. Strike follows the show - everyone expected to help.

  - Saturday rehearsals may start at 10am but Sunday rehearsals will never be called before 1pm.

By signing this contract, cast members agreed to its conditions. Failure to live up to any part of this contract by the cast member may constitute grounds for dismissal of the Company member from the production. Such action is at the discretion of the director.

- 1. Each company member is required to attend, on time, every rehearsal for which you are scheduled. You gave us your conflict schedule and the director will set the schedule to their best ability knowing those conflicts. If we schedule a rehearsal on a given conflict. We know that and that missed rehearsal is excused. If we get to a 3<sup>rd</sup> unmarked conflict (unexcused) and a 3<sup>rd</sup> missed a rehearsal-You may be removed from the production.
- 2. Each company member must fulfill personal obligations to the show, as they are scheduled. These obligations include, but are not limited to, memorization deadlines, costumes and prop deadlines.
- 3. All cast members are asked promote the show and to sell tickets. There is no minimum number to sell, but you are the shows best advertisement.
- 4. This production's success is based on you making the production priority over other activities outside of work. We have committed to you; you must commit to us. If being in the show is causing too many conflicts with other activities, then you need to make a choice which one to commit during the Music Man rehearsal and show production time.
